From Bregenz on Lake Constance, it's only a 1.5-hour drive to Bielerhöhe, the southernmost point of Vorarlberg with views of Piz Buin and the Ochsenentaler Glacier.

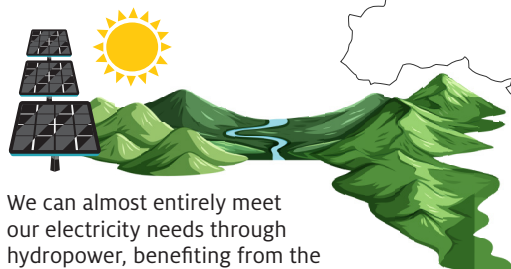
